Section III: Prepositions

Preposition (A.B)

A preposition is a word or group of words that combine with a noun or pronoun to form a phrase that usually acts as an adverb, adjective, or noun. "With" in the sentence: "the house **with** the red door" is a preposition.

OR

A preposition is a word placed before a noun or a pronoun to show in what selection the person or thing indicated by it stands in regard to something else:

1. He is fond of tea.

2. He is ashamed **of** his behavior.

3. He was angry with me.

4. She was absent **from** the class.

5. Let us hope **for** the best.
