- 6. All exam papers will be MCQ based, except for English Compulsory (MCQ & CRQ/ERQ), Urdu Compulsory (MCQ & CRQ/ERQ), Urdu Aasan (MCQ & CRQ/ERQ) and Sindhi (MCQ & CRQ/ERQ).
