QUALIFICATIONS, EXPERIENCE AND AGE LIMITS FOR INITIAL APPOINTMENT

- (iv) eligibility of candidates shall be reckoned as on the closing date fixed for submission of application in accordance with this notification and the instructions issued by Federal Government and Federal Public Services Commission from time to time.






